

## Dear Parent/Carer,

I am pleased to share our planned trips and visits for the next academic year. By providing this information in advance, we hope it will help you and your child choose which trips to attend and are able to plan accordingly in terms of time and finance.

## **Key Information:**

- Each trip includes the approximate launch date and expected cost. Please note, both dates and costs may change.
- Some tour operators require quick deposits once the final price is given. Sharing this schedule now should help you plan ahead and spread costs where possible.
- Many trips, especially overseas or higher-cost ones, are launched early (sometimes a year in advance) to give families plenty of time to pay in instalments.

## Please note:

- This list is not exhaustive. Smaller trips, subject-specific visits, and those with little or no cost may not be included here. Additional opportunities may also arise during the year.
- Many trips use a ballot system if oversubscribed. Register your interest within 7 days of launch; if needed, places will be allocated by ballot, and a reserve list will be kept.
- Deposits and payments are often non-refundable, as we have to commit funds to external providers early. Please make sure your child is fully committed before signing up to avoid financial loss.
- If a student's behaviour does not meet our expectations, we may withdraw them from a trip at any stage, including while on the trip.

You will receive detailed information about each trip as it becomes available throughout the year.
