Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to invite you and your child to the 'Year 12 Parents' Post 18 Options Information Evening'. This event will take place on **Thursday 4 May, in the auditorium** which is in the Sports and Arts block. It will start at 6.30pm and last approximately 1½ hours.

The main purpose of the evening is:

- To provide parents with the necessary information in order to support their child through the pathways available after Sixth Form.
- To ensure parents are fully aware of the procedures and options available and the Higher Education Application Process.

The format for the evening will be a presentation on all post 18 options, including the UCAS process; how to make the decision; what admissions tutors are looking for; financial issues; Apprenticeships and Gap Years. There will also be the opportunity to discuss any post 18 issues/concerns. In addition, presentations will also be made by former students who have undertaken the degree apprenticeship route and are now fully qualified in their profession.
