Dear Parent/Carer

This week, we have started setting homework for our Year 7 students. I hope you will find the information below helpful for supporting your child with their homework.

Teachers set homework according to the homework schedule. You can find this on the Guiseley School website: <u>www.guiseleyschool.org.uk/homework</u>. We encourage students to copy the homework schedule into their planners, so they know which subjects to expect homework from each day. For example, on a Monday students will be set English homework in addition to the 15 minutes reading that is already printed in the planner.

Teachers might direct students to the VLE, Teams, Educake or Hegarty Maths to find the instructions or tasks for their homework.

<u>VLE</u>

- 1. Visit the Guiseley School website: <u>www.guiseleyschool.org.uk</u>
- 2. Click the 'VLE' button in the top right corner.
- 3. Log into the VLE. Students need to use their school email address and password. This is printed on a sticker in their planner. Their email address is their username + @guiseleyschool.org.uk.
- 4. Click 'Subjects' on the right.
- 5. Click the subject that has set homework.

<u>Teams</u>

- 1. Log into the VLE.
- 2. Click the 9 dots in the top left corner and click Teams.
- 3. Click the Teams page for the subject that has set homework.

<u>Educake</u>

- 1. Log into the VLE.
- 2. Click 'Educake'.
- 3. Log into Educake using the username and instructions provided by the subject teacher.

Hegarty Maths

- 1. Visit <u>www.hegartymaths.com</u>
- 2. Click 'Student Login' at the top.
- 3. Students enter their name and date of birth.
- 4. Students generate their own password.
