• 11.30am-12.20pm: Period 4


• 12.20-12.50pm: Lunch time

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# Other communication


- For confidential matters or to pass on information during the school day, you can email **info@guiseleyschool.org.uk**.

- Astro trainers/dimple boots are not suitable for either the new pitch or the grass pitches.






- Students can ask permission from the Year 7 Team if they need to use their phone in an emergency.




# Independence and organisation
