The exam board documents tell you about some things that <u>YOU MUST & MUST NOT DO</u> when you are completing your work, and coursework.

Taking someone else's words, thoughts or ideas and trying to pass them off as your own is known as *PLAGIARISM*. It is a form of cheating which is taken very seriously, and the penalties are severe. Those penalties are clearly listed on both of the attached Notices to Candidates
