Return to School - September

Monday 4th and Tuesday 5th September will be training days for school staff. **Students will return on Wednesday** 6th **September.**

Wednesday 6th September:

Students in years 8-11 will need to be at school in their form room at 12.30pm. Staff will be available to meet them and advise them of their form room location as they arrive. A lunch service will not be available so students will need to eat before they arrive in school. The school site will open to students in Year 8 – 11 from 12.15.

All students will need to bring their lanyard, a pencil case & reading book. PE kit & exercise books will not be required as they will be with Form Tutors. Planners and timetables will be issued on the day.

Lockers

We are delighted to offer your child the continued use of a locker whilst they are in school this new academic year. If you wish for your child to continue using a locker, we will need a payment of £3. The cost covers administration, maintenance, and replacement keys for the lockers. We have managed to reduce the charge from £5 in previous years to £3 to help in this current economic climate. Payments can be made via our online payments system ParentPay from Wednesday 6th September.

Reading

We have a had a very successful year promoting reading for pleasure with students, staff and parents/carers. Alongside attendance rates, reading for pleasure is the factor which has the biggest impact on student progress. To that end, reading tests are currently taking place for the current Years 7-9. The results from these will help us track the progress students have made this year and help us to understand how best to support students over the course of the first term. Reading tests for our new Year 7 cohort will take place from September.

We hope your child has been able to engage with our Guiseley School Summer Reading Challenge with the aim of reading for 150,000 minutes over the course of the holiday.
